4:30 PM - Nancy Cassagne, CEO of West Jefferson Medical Center and PE homeowners just sent me an email that says, "WB is fine. Power is out everywhere. Tree down on Wall Blvd. Minor stuff. Haven't gotten all clear from officials yet but we are good. WJ is on full generator power."

4:15 PM - A friend and PE homeowner who stayed in the French Quarter said, "I appears that we did not sustain any substantial damage at the F.Q. condo or at home."

12:30 PM - Terry Talamo said, "Just left Plantation, looked at every house. I saw no roof damage or no other serious damage however winds have increasd. Harvey Canal looks good but we are expecting an increase in water level. No street flooding or any other flooding on West Bank at this time. Keep praying we still have several hours to go. Thanks."
