JULY 12TH CRIME SWEEP VIOLATIONS

Today, Jefferson Parish Departments, Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office, and utility agencies participated in the fourth Jefferson Parish crime sweep. The inspections took place on Marcie Street, Park Manor Drive, Wychwood Drive, Longwood Drive, and Madewood Drive in Metairie. As a result, the following violations were reported:
