TODAY'S CRIME SWEEP VIOLATIONS

Today, Jefferson Parish Departments, Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office and utility agencies participated in Jefferson Parish's eight Crime Sweep. The inspections took place on Lac la Belle Drive, Lac Dumoine Drive, Lac St. Pierre Drive, Lac du Bay Drive, Lac Couture Drive and Lac Bienville Drive. All streets located in the Timber Ridge Subdivision in Harvey, Louisiana 70058

As a result of today's crime sweep, the following violations were reported:
