## Jefferson Parish Council will Keep Citizens Informed Free E-mail Service Launched in Jefferson Parish

Jefferson Parish citizens can now register for a new service that will allow them to receive e-mail messages from either the Parish President, Council-at-Large members, District Council members or all.

The service is called "Citizen Contact" and is free to the public. When the Parish President or a Council member has news or information for their constituents, they are able to email messages to all those enrolled in the service.

Those who want to only receive information about issues in and around their neighborhood can sign up to receive messages from their district council representative. Citizens who want to receive information about issues parish wide can choose to receive e-mails from the Parish President, the two Council-at-Large members and any or all of the five district Council members. Once registered, citizens can change their choices at any time if they decide to receive messages from more or fewer elected officials, and they can unsubscribe at any time.

That will take you to a simple form that will ask for your e-mail address and allow you to choose the parish elected officials from whom you would receive messages.
