## CODE AND ZONING VIOLATIONS STATUS NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE

efferson Parish today launched an on-line system that will allow citizens to keep track of violations reported to the Jefferson Parish Inspection and Code Enforcement Department.

These complaints include abandoned vehicles, buildings in disrepair, high grass and weeds, and zoning violations such as businesses being operated in residentially zoned areas.

As of today, citizens can learn the status of a complaint on-line at <a href="https://www.jeffparish.net">www.jeffparish.net</a>. On the right side of the parish's home page is a list called "Online Services." To quickly find where a violation is in the system and the action that has been taken, click on "Code Violation Complaint Status."

"This is a new weapon in Jefferson Parish's fight against blight," Parish President Aaron Broussard said. "It's a way for citizens to see what is being done about code and zoning problems in their neighborhoods or anywhere in the parish."

The on-line system contains information on all Code Enforcement cases as of January 1, 2007. Citizens can call 736-6961 for information on zoning violations and property maintenance violations issued before Jan. 1 of this year.

"Our neighborhood Civic Associations and individual citizens will find this a valuable tool to help maintain the quality of life in our parish," said Broussard.
