Sector Gate

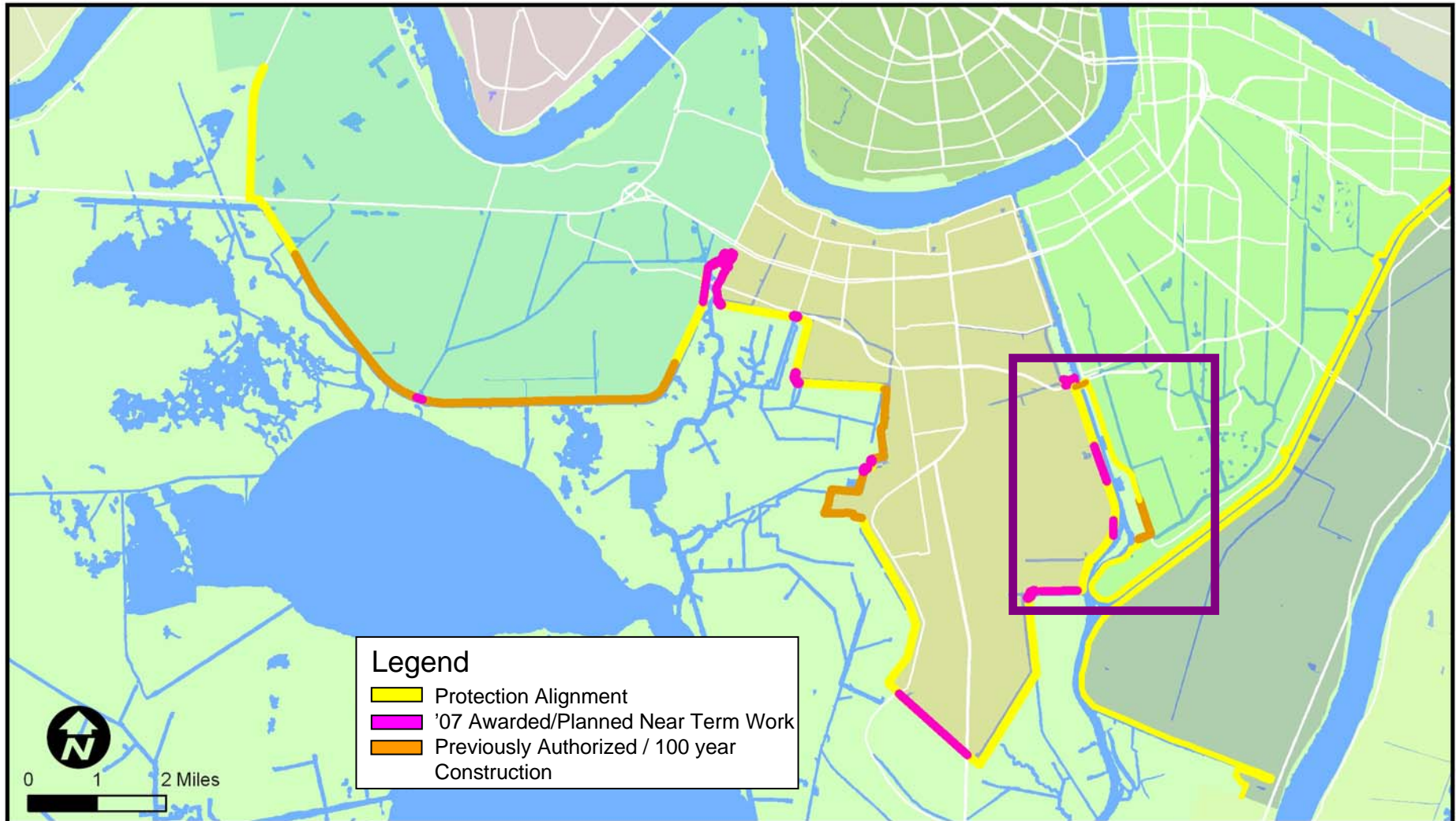


- Ability to affect closure across the canal to +8 ft achieved 01 Aug 07.
- Sector Gate and temporary pumps successfully tested and operable.



Previously Authorized and 100 yr construction

- 10 miles of levee currently under construction to previously authorized levels
- 1.5 miles of floodwall currently under construction to 100 yr elevation
